| What is the overall deductible? | \$5,000 per member / \$10,000 per family for a participating provider and \$10,000 per member / \$20,000 per family for a non-participating provider . | Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan , each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible . |
| Are there services covered before you meet your deductible? | Yes. Preventive care and ACA preventive drugs are covered before you meet your deductible . | This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible . If you have other family members in this plan , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met. |
| What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit? | Premiums , balance billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover. | Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit . |
